Please help us to remember to turn to you for direction and guidance.	Lord, place in our hearts the understanding of who you are. Let us know that our identity is rooted in the fact that we are your sons and daughters. Let our desire for your delight outweigh our bent desires to please those around us. We want to be pleasing to you, so God, we turn toward you and yield ourselves to you.	How often we look at our brother or sister with disapproval or judgment while ignoring the sin in our own lives.
