<p><i>PRAYER WILL CHANGE YOUR LIFE... PRAY ANYTIME, ANYWHERE!</i></p>			<p>1 <i>Mark 1:29-39</i> Lord Jesus, your power is displayed in incredible ways, and we stand in awe of you. Following your example, help us prioritize the time to talk to God. Prayer is a vital link between us and God, and we want to honor that relationship by spending time with our Father.</p>	<p>2 <i>John 15:9-17</i> Jesus, help me to obey your commandments and to remain in your love. My joy overflows when I am reminded of your love. Provide ways for me today to share your love with others so they, too, will experience the joy that comes from knowing you.</p>	<p>3 <i>1 Thessalonians 1:1-10</i> God, how wonderful is it that when we believe in you, your power is within us! Your power changes people. Remind us that when we tell others about Christ, we must depend on the Holy Spirit to open their eyes and convince them that they need salvation. Not to us but to your name be the glory!</p>	<p>4 <i>Matthew 11:28-30</i> Holy Lord, there are days when my burden seems so heavy. Whether this is due to sin, life's demands, oppression, or weariness in my search for you, you free me from all these burdens! The rest you promise is love, healing, and peace with God. <p>5 <i>Acts 2:37-41</i> Father God, we know that we can't save ourselves; only you can save us. We must turn away from our selfishness and rebellion and turn to Christ. Help us depend on him for forgiveness, mercy, guidance, and purpose. Remind us that our baptism identifies us with Christ and with the community of believers. We are thankful to be part of God's family!</p>	<p>6 <i>Ephesians 2:1-10</i> Almighty God, we are beyond grateful that because of your mercy and great love for us, we are made alive in Christ. It is by grace we have been saved, through faith. This is a gift from you. Let us respond with our gratitude, praise, and joy by seeking to serve others with kindness, love, and gentleness.</p>	<p>7 <i>Luke 12:1-12</i> Father God, our peers judge us by how we perform, what we achieve, or how we look. However, we know our true value is your estimate of our worth. Remind us that because you care for us and because we belong to you, we can face life without fear. We have the power to honor Christ with all parts of our lives.</p>	<p>8 <i>Psalms 23:1-6</i> Gracious God, I praise you for being my shepherd and providing for my needs. Thank you for your promise to guide and protect me through life and that I get to spend eternity with you. I am thankful for the times of peace and quiet you provide when I can rest in your care and renew my strength.</p>	<p>9 <i>James 5:13-16</i> Jesus, you are Lord over my body and spirit. In good times, may I rejoice in your name and sing your praises. In times of sin and darkness, help me to call upon your name to seek guidance and to lean on the support from the community of believers around me.</p>	<p>10 <i>Acts 10:9-16</i> Holy God, the earth and everything in it is yours. Humans were made in your image. No one is inferior to anybody else. You can redeem anyone. Help us to look for opportunities to share your love with everyone we encounter, no matter their station in life. Let us be your instruments in reaching people to tell them the Good News!</p>	<p>11 <i>2 Kings 6:1-7</i> Gracious and Loving God, we are so thankful that you are always present in our lives. You care and provide for us, even in the insignificant events of everyday life. Help us to trust in you in all aspects of our lives, from the big things to the small things.</p>
<p>12 <i>Psalms 33:16-22</i> Father God, when bad things happen and we are faced with harsh realities, help us to focus on your wise judgments. We can place our hope in you in good times and in bad. We are grateful for your offer to save us. We trust in you and your plans for our life.</p>	<p>13 <i>2 Timothy 3:14-17</i> Holy God, we know that the Bible isn't just a collection of stories; rather, it's your inspired Word. Since it is trustworthy, we should read it and apply it to our lives. Remind us that we shouldn't just be reading your Word, but we also need to apply it by doing Christ's work in the world.</p>	<p>14 <i>Isaiah 43:1-7</i> Jesus, you are the savior of the world! We know that we are important to you and that we belong to you. How wonderful that we get to be part of God's great family! Because we bear God's name, let us never do anything that would bring shame to it. All honor and glory is yours, now and forever.</p>	<p>15 <i>Romans 16:1-16</i> O Lord, there are many Christians who have walked the path before us. There will be many more that also come behind us. Help us to be mindful of the role we play in guiding others to know Jesus. Open our eyes to see the people around us who need to know about your love.</p>	<p>16 <i>Ephesians 4:1-13</i> Father God, all believers in Christ belong to one body and are called to be united for Jesus. Instead of concentrating on what divides us, remind us of what unites us. Help us to be true representatives of Jesus by being humble, gentle, patient, understanding, and peaceful. At times when we face great troubles, it can be easy for us to focus on the pain rather than the ultimate goal. Help us focus on the reward for our faith and the joy that lasts forever.</p>	<p>21 <i>Romans 8:22-27</i> Heavenly Father, how wonderful it is that you never make a promise that you don't keep. There are times when your plan takes longer than we expect. In those moments as we wait for your will to unfold, help us to have patience and to place our confidence in your goodness and wisdom.</p>	<p>22 <i>1 Chronicles 4:9-10</i> Father God, like Jabez, we ask for your blessing over our lives. We pray for you to take your rightful position as Lord over our work, our family time, and our recreation. Help us to obey you daily in all that we say and do.
