## **HOMELESS OUTREACH MINISTRY (STOP – Salvation Total Outreach Program)**

Ways to serve: Food Donations, food prep, food servers, table leaders and clean up crew (Note: These areas of serving will resume once we open up for dining indoors.)

## **TREND COMMUNITY HOUSE**

As an outreach we maintain a house in the Trend community (40th and L) where we reach out to support families in need.

**After-school program** for children of the neighborhood, grades K-12, provides homework assistance daily, a Bible lesson, prayer time and snacks.

**Farmer's Market** (bi-monthly) where neighborhood families receive canned goods and fresh vegetables.

**Special activities** throughout the year, including summer and holiday field trips, Thanksgiving food, Christmas party and gifts, new shoes for school and backpacks and supplies for school.
