God's 3 Day Rule &

The Difficulty Of God's Timing

He does everything just right and on time, but people can never completely understand what he is doing.

—Ecclesiastes 3:11 (NCV)

From then on Jesus began to tell his disciples plainly that it was necessary for him to go to Jerusalem, and that he would suffer many terrible things... He would be killed, but on the third day he would be raised from the dead.

—Matthew 16:21 (NLT)

Then they said, "Let's bring the Ark of the Covenant of the Lord from Shiloh. If we carry it into battle with us, it will save us from our enemies."

—1 Samuel 4:3 (NLT)

3 Kinds Of Days:

1. Day 1- **Despair.**

- *She named the child Ichabod (which means “the glory is gone!”), for she said, “Israel’s glory is gone.” She named him this because the Ark of God had been captured and because her father-in-law and husband were dead. Then she said, “The glory has departed from Israel, for the Ark of God has been captured.”*

—1 Samuel 4:21-22 (NLT)

- *At about three o’clock, Jesus called out with a loud voice, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” which means “My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?”*

—Matthew 27:46 (NLT)

- *Darkness fell across the whole land... Then Jesus shouted out again, and he released his spirit... The earth shook, rocks split apart.*

—Matthew 27:45-51 (NLT)

- *Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.*

—2 Corinthians 4:16-18 (NIV)

2. Day 2- **Confusion, Anxiety & Hidden Combat.**

- *When the citizens of Ashdod went to see it the next morning, Dagon had fallen with his face to the ground in front of the Ark of the Lord! So they took Dagon and put him in his place again.*

—1 Samuel 5:3 (NLT)

- *But the next morning the same thing happened—Dagon had fallen face down before the Ark of the LORD again. This time his head and hands had*

broken off and were lying in the doorway. Only the trunk of his body was left intact.

—1 Samuel 5:4 (NLT)

- *And in the spirit he went and preached to the spirits in prison who refused to obey God long ago in the time of Noah.*

—1 Peter 3:19-20 (NCV)

3. Day 3- The Glory Returns.

- *The people of Beth-shemesh were harvesting wheat in the valley, and when they saw the Ark, they were overjoyed!*

—1 Samuel 6:13 (NLT)

- *Sir, we remember that while that liar was still alive he said, 'After three days I will rise from the dead.' So give the order for the tomb to be guarded closely till the third day.*

—Matthew 27:63-64 (NCV)

- *"Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive? He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Remember what he told you back in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be betrayed into the hands of sinful men and be crucified, and that he would rise again on the third day." Then they remembered...*

—Luke 24:5-8 (NLT)

- *And we know that all that happens to us is working for our good if we love God and are fitting into his plans.*

—Romans 8:28 (NLT)
