The Courage Of Joseph

1. Moral Courage- (Integrity) He Was A Good Man.

• Joseph her husband was a righteous man.

2. Relational Courage- (Nobility) He Was A Noble Man.

• Joseph her husband was a righteous man and did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.

• The LORD has told you what is good, and this is what he requires of you: to do what is right, to love mercy...

—*Micah 6:8 (NLT)*

3. Spiritual Courage- (Humility) He Was A Humble Man.

• As he considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. "Joseph, son of David," the angel said, "do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife. For the child within her was conceived by the Holy Spirit. And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."
