It was nearly time for the Jewish Passover celebration, so Jesus went to Jerusalem.

—*Iohn 2:1-2 (NLT)* 

# This Story Teaches Us...

# 1. The Mission Of Jesus.

Then his disciples remembered this prophecy from the Scriptures: "Passion for God's house will















 Then the Lord God planted a garden in Eden in the east, and there he placed the man he had made... In the middle of the garden he placed the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

—*Genesis 2:8-9 (NLT)* 

- The Lord God placed the man in the Garden of Eden to tend (abad) and watch over (samar) it. —Genesis 2:15 (NLT)
- They will also maintain (samar) all the furnishings of the sacred tent, serving (abad) in the Tabernacle on behalf of all the Israelites.

-Numbers 3:8 (NLT)

• That day Gad came to David and said to him, "Go up and build an altar to the Lord on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite..." "So David paid him fifty pieces of silver for the threshing floor and the oxen.

-2 Samuel 24:18-24 (NLT)

 When the priests withdrew from the Holy Place, the cloud filled the temple of the Lord. 11 And the priests could not perform their service because of the cloud, for the glory of the Lord filled his temple.

—1 Kings 8:10-11 (NIV)

• Then the glory of the Lord departed from over the threshold of the temple... stopped at the entrance of the east gate of the Lord's house, and the glory of the God of Israel was above them.

-Ezekiel 10:18-19 (NIV)

• The glory of the Lord went up from within the city and stopped above the mountain east of it... Then

the vision I had seen went up from me, and I told the exiles everything the Lord had shown me. —Ezekiel 11:23-25 (NIV)

• I saw a man whose appearance was like bronze...
The man said to me, "Son of man, look carefully and listen closely and pay attention to everything I am going to show you, for that is why you have been brought here. Tell the people of Israel everything you see."

*—Ezekiel 40:3-4 (NIV)* 

• But many of the older priests and Levites and family heads, who had seen the former temple, wept aloud when they saw the foundation of this temple being laid.

-Ezra 3:12 (NIV)

• The Jews then responded to him, "What sign can you show us to prove your authority to do all this?" Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and I will raise it again in three days." They replied, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and you are going to raise it in three days?" But the temple he had spoken of was his body. After he was raised from the dead, his disciples recalled what he had said.

—John 2:18-22 (NLT)

\* But when he saw many Pharisees and Sadducees coming to watch him baptize, he denounced them. "You brood of snakes!" he exclaimed. "Who warned you to flee the coming wrath? Prove by the way you live that you have repented of your sins and turned to God... Even now the ax of God's judgment is poised, ready to sever the roots of the trees. Yes, every tree that does not produce good fruit will be chopped down and thrown into the fire.

• But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff.

-*Matthew 3:11-12 (NIV)* 

• Destroy this temple, and I will raise it again in three days.

—John 2:19 (NLT)

• Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body.

*─1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (NLT)* 

• You are coming to Christ, who is the living cornerstone of God's temple. He was rejected by people, but he was chosen by God for great honor. And you are living stones that God is building into his spiritual temple. What's more, you are his holy priests. Through the mediation of Jesus Christ, you offer spiritual sacrifices that please God.

—1 Peter 2:4-5 (NLT)
