# The Year Of Jesus #10 The Wedding At Cana: Jesus Reveals His Glory

On the third day there was a wedding celebration in the village of Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, and Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the celebration.

—*John 2:1-2 (NLT)* 

# What Did We Learn:

1. Jesus Cares About Small Stuff.

• The wine supply ran out during the festivities, so Jesus' mother told him, "They have no more wine." "Dear woman, that's not our problem," Jesus replied. "My time has not yet come." But his mother told the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

—John 2:3-5 (NLT)

• This miraculous sign at Cana in Galilee was the first time Jesus revealed his glory. And his disciples put their faith in him.

—John 2:11 (NLT)

# 2. How Important Joy Is.

- Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet."
   —John 2:6-8 (NLT)
- He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate— bringing forth food from the earth: wine that gladdens human hearts, oil to make their faces shine, and bread that sustains their hearts.

## 3. That Jesus Is Lord Of The Party.

• Now dip some out, and take it to the master of ceremonies." So the servants followed his instructions. When the master of ceremonies tasted the water that was now wine, not knowing where it had come from (though, of course, the servants knew), he called the bridegroom over. "A host always serves the best wine first," he said. "Then, when everyone has had a lot to drink, he brings out the less expensive wine. But you have kept the best until now!"
