# **Storming The Gates Of Hell:**

# 1. A Time Of <u>Preparation</u>.

• When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea
Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say
that the Son of Man is?" "Well," they replied,
"some say John the Baptist, some say Elijah, and
others say Jeremiah or one of the other prophets."
Then he asked them, "But who do you say I am?"
Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son
of the living God."

-Matthew 16:13-16 (NLT)

• Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven. And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell will not overcome it.

-Matthew 16:17-18 (NLT)

## 2. A Time Of Galvanizing.

• But Peter took him aside and began to reprimand him... "Heaven forbid, Lord," he said. "This will never happen to you!" Jesus turned to Peter and said, "Get away from me, Satan! You are a dangerous trap to me. You are seeing things merely from a human point of view, not from God's."

-Matthew 16:22-23 (NLT)

• Six days later Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed so that his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. Suddenly, Moses and Elijah appeared and began talking with Jesus.

-Matthew 17:1-3 (NLT)

• After they gathered again in Galilee, Jesus said, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of his enemies He will be killed, but on the third day he will be raised from the dead." And the disciples were filled with grief.

-Matthew 17:22-23 (NLT)

• "Listen," he said, "we're going up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be betrayed to the leading priests and the teachers of religious law. They will sentence him to die. Then they will hand him over to the Romans to be mocked, flogged with a whip, and crucified. But on the third day he will be raised from the dead."

-Matthew 20:17-19 (NLT)

# 3. The Final <u>Days</u>.

• When he reached the place where the road started down the Mount of Olives, all of his followers began to shout and sing as they walked along, praising God for all the wonderful miracles they had seen. "Blessings on the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in highest heaven!" The Pharisees said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples!" "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out."

—Luke 19:36-40 (NLT)

• When Jesus had finished saying all these things, he said to his disciples, "As you know, Passover begins in two days, and the Son of Man will be handed over to be crucified." At that same time the leading priests and elders were meeting at the residence of Caiaphas, the high priest, plotting how to capture Jesus secretly and kill him.

-*Matthew 26:1-5 (NLT)* 

### 4. The Final Hours.

• While they were eating, he said, "I tell you the truth, one of you will betray me." Greatly distressed, each one asked in turn, "Am I the one, Lord?"

-Matthew 26:21-22 (NLT)

• He took Peter, James, and John with him, and he became deeply troubled and distressed. He told them, "My soul is crushed with grief to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."

-Mark 14:33-34 (NLT)

• "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done." ...And being in anguish, he prayed more earnestly, and his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground.

-Luke 22:42-44 (NLT)

• Jesus knew that his mission was now finished, and... he said, "It is finished!" Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.
