1. Don't (try to) Limit God.

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. And God saw that the light was good. Then he separated the light from the darkness. God called the light "day" and the darkness "night."

And evening passed and morning came, marking the first day."

• "But some said, "This man healed a blind man. Couldn't he have kept Lazarus from dying?" Jesus was still angry as he arrived at the tomb, a cave with a stone rolled across its entrance. 2. Expect Surprises.

replied, "Seven loaves, and a few small fish." So
Jesus told all the people to sit down on the ground.
Then he took the seven loaves and the fish, thanked

the crowd. They all ate as much as they wanted.
Afterward, the disciples picked up seven large
baskets of leftover food. There were 4,000 men
who were fed that day, in addition to all the women
and children. Then Jesus sent the people home, and
he got into a boat and crossed over to the region of
Magadan."
