4 Kinds Of Unanswered Prayers:

1. No.

• Three different times I begged God to make me well again. Each time he said, "No. But I am with you; that is all you need. My power shows up best in weak people." Now I am glad to boast about how weak I am; I am glad to be a living demonstration of Christ's power, instead of showing off my own power and abilities... for when I am weak, then I am strong.

• She said, "Promise that one of my sons will sit at your right side and the other will sit at your left side in your kingdom." But Jesus said, "You don't understand what you are asking."

-Matthew 20:21-22 (NCV)

• When James and John saw this, they said to Jesus, "Lord, should we call down fire from heaven to burn them up.

2. Slow.

• These things I plan won't happen right away. Slowly, steadily, surely, the time approaches when the vision will be fulfilled. If it seems slow, wait patiently, for it will surely take place. It will not be delayed.
