



We have prayed, we have planned, and we have prepared. WinShape is here! With a week of registration to go, we already have 215 kids signed up!! We have over 50 volunteers!! Churches have come together! Communities have supported! Now what?

Now, we be present. Today is the day. If we dwell on the past, we are thinking about it in the present. If we worry about the future, we are thinking about it in the present. We cannot change the past, but we can change the future. We change the future by the decisions we make in the present. Do what God is calling us to do now – today.

The author of Galatians teaches us to walk in the Spirit. This command to walk in the Spirit is a form of a present tense command that indicates one starts walking in the Spirit and then is always presently walking in the Spirit. The Spirit then produces fruit in our lives and is ripe exactly when we need it. "Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary." Let's be diligent in doing what we are to be doing now in the present as we walk in the Spirit, and let's enjoy what God is going to do!
