Unless You Are Converted

Conversion is a process of change. Jesus talks about a very real change in our hearts, minds and souls (Matt 18:1-6). In order for this to happen, we must change the one we are trying to please. They, as children, trusted Him who had always submitted to His own Father's will (John 8:29). As children, they followed Him.


