How do you feel about the symbolism of the cross?

In reality, what does the cross represent?

How can the cross be both beautiful and horrific at the same time?

How do people humiliate the faith and how does that make you feel?

Read Psalm 22 (A Messianic Psalm) and think about the suffering of Christ.

1Corinthians1: 18

18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

- What has blinded people to power of the cross? Why do men choose the things of the world over the power of the cross?
- The word foolish is applied to those who are being put to death, day by day, in their lives which are rendered as useless. Our lives are not to be useless, rather to be full of power. What does *Jesus power* look like in your life?

In Corinth spiritual divisions were sabotaging the impact of this church upon the city so that much of what had started out with tremendous power was beginning to fade away because of the divisions within the congregation.

- What might be some contentions among our church members that might cause a division of unity?
- We usually think of the gospel as something that non-Christians need to hear, but the New Testament makes very clear to us that it is Christians who need to understand the gospel. Why?

John 14:12: *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.*

Jesus has changed the world in a way no other person ever has, and yet in John 14 Jesus says *He that believes on me will do greater works*. Discuss how can that be?

1 Corinthians 1:20 *Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?*

- The great thing about God is that what we deem wise, He deems foolish. And what we deem foolish, He deems as wise. The wisdom of the world is pure foolishness to God. Take a look at the current world situation...music, movies, politics, religion. What do you think God is thinking about us?
