2. God remembered Noah and all those in the ark: Genesis 8:1-4
  - a. God’s punishment of the world by the flood was finished.
    - 1) “strong wind” –
    - 2) “ruach” Hebrew word for wind. Also used for Spirit.
  - b. God kept Noah, his family and all the animals safe. Genesis 8:14-19
    - 1) God always does what He says He will do.
  - c. The Biblical account of the flood is true:
  - d. The Biblical account of the flood is the record of an eye witness to the events.
    - 1) So, where did all of this water go?
    - 2) Psalms 104:6-9 –
    - 3) Interesting observation from verse 4 –
3. God gave commands to Noah and set the rainbow as a sign:
  - a. Noah offered animal sacrifices to the Lord. Genesis 8:20-22
  - b. God accepted Noah’s offerings: Verse 20
    - 1) Why did Noah step out of the Ark and to the altar?
    - 2) Did Noah begin to look at these animals as a picture of substitution?
    - 3) Noah offers “burnt offerings” –
    - 4) Interesting parallel to Romans 12:1 –
  - c. God gave His commands and promises to Noah. Genesis 9:1-7
    - 1) “be fruitful and multiply, and replenish the earth” –
    - 2) Animals would be afraid of man. Verse 2

3) Man could eat meat as permitted by God. Verse 3

4) Capital punishment is instituted by God. Verse 5-6

d. God gave the rainbow as the sign of His promise. Genesis 9:8-17

1) God promises to not destroy the world again by water.
