

Kids of the Bible - Samuel

1 Samuel 17

The aim of this session is to learn that with faith in God, David was able to do big things. David had an amazing relationship with God. He loved and trusted God, and by relying on God, he had the strength to stand up and defeat the giant Goliath. David was small but with God's help he did big things.

Prayer: "Lord I am weak but you can help me to be strong. Lord, I am small but you are bigger than anything and you can help me. Amen."

Memory verse: "The Battle is the Lord's." 1 Samuel 17:47

Craft:

Here are a few different crafts for you to chose from:

- Colouring-in sheet
- A maze
- Learning the memory verse: cut out and sort the stones to match the printed verse.
- David's bag of stones:


Collect five small stones and one bigger stone. Colour the five little stones. Use a small paper bag, cup or little pouch to carry the five little stones as a reminder of the story.

Game:

In a safe place (maybe outside) place the bigger stone on the ground, and take a couple of steps back. See who can hit the big stone "Goliath" with one little stone, like David. (Instead of stones, you can use marbles, buttons, etc.)


