John 2:1-11

Jesus performed his first miracle at a wedding in the city of Cana. When the hosts ran out of wine to serve the guests, Mary had total confidence that her son, Jesus, would take care of the situation. He miraculously turned plain water into excellent wine.

The point of this miracle is that **Jesus cares about the small things**. It's not a life ending thing to run out of wine at a wedding, but it is embarrassing. It could be very embarrassing for the family. But, **Jesus solved the problem for them**. He made it all better by giving them more wine and helping them.

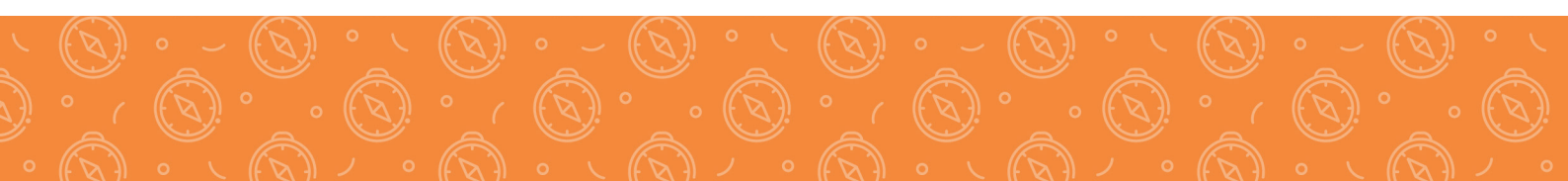
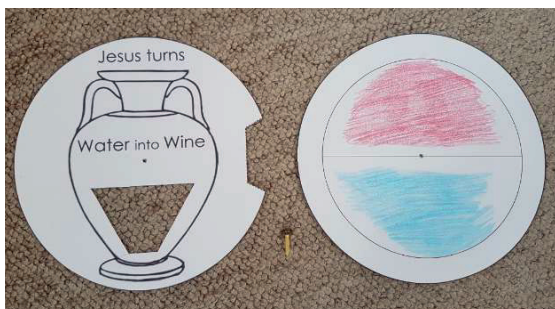

Review questions:

1. In what city did Jesus perform His first miracle?
2. What kind of event was Jesus attending when He performed His first miracle?
3. What was Jesus' first miracle?

Craft:

- You need: 2 sheets of white paper or card, scissors, coloured pens, and one paper fastener (split pin)

- On the 'jar' circle, cut out the hatched areas.
