**Camp Code**

1. All campers are required to attend all services and scheduled daily events. No one is to venture from their designated group and/or cabin leader without permission from the camp directors.
2. The following items are absolutely PROHIBITED on the campground for all individuals: weapons, fireworks, alcohol, tobacco and drugs of any kind (i.e. cigarettes, chewing tobacco, e-cigarettes, vapes, Juuls, etc.). Leave these items at home. Do NOT bring them with you!
3. Electronic devices (i.e. cell phones, iPods, mp3 players, tablets, video games, TVs, radios, and any other similar electronic) will not be allowed on the campground by campers. These items will be collected at registration for safekeeping until the last day of camp.
4. A respectful Christian consideration will be expected toward all individuals at camp. PDA is not allowed. There will be no cussing or fighting. Any rebellious actions will merit a call to the parent and/or pastor to take such a person home immediately.
5. The dress code is centered around the word “modesty” in the Christian sense. Short skirts, halter tops, short shorts, or form fitting garments are considered immodest. A shirt, shorts/pants, and shoes are to be worn when outside of the cabin at all times.
6. Swimwear will be of modest apparel. Brief or bikini swimwear for men is considered immodest. Bikini swimwear for ladies is also considered immodest. A dark shirt will be required for immodest swimwear.
7. We are at camp to have a good time of spiritual refreshing and growth in a Christian environment. Let’s prove to ourselves and to others that we can have a great time at camp!
