LOGISTICS FOR REOPENING questCHURCH on May 17, 2020

OUR MISSION: To safely provide a physical worship experience for those of you who are comfortable, able, and ready to assemble with others that is safe, spacious and sanitized. Our goal is for every guest to feel safer here than other public places you may go.

- We are sensitive and understanding to the fact that there are those who are not able or ready to return to meeting physically at this time. We welcome and encourage anyone not ready to return to worship with us online.
- Please join us online if you have had these symptoms this week:
 - Temp over 100
 - Coughing or sore throat
 - Shortness of breath
 - Contact with anyone confirmed to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days

UPON ARRIVAL:

- The Parking Lot Team will guide you to park in every other stall.
- Please wait to be directed from your car in a fashion to ensure social distancing from other families walking to the church doors.
- We will have a mask distribution tent out front; all volunteers will be wearing masks as a courtesy to our guests.
 - We have free fabric masks as our gift to you; wear it at quest and keep to wash and wear as you like.
 - We strongly encourage guests to wear masks, but it is not required per our state and CDC guidelines.
 - NOTE: Masks are NOT to be worn by children 2 years old and under; parents should also decide for young children as they tend to touch their face more with a mask on.
 - Our onstage presenters, including the worship team, will not wear masks while on stage.

VOLUNTEERS WILL ASSIST YOU:

- Our goal is to get you from your car to your seat in the auditorium as efficiently as possible.
- There will be no food or drinks offered. You are welcome to bring your own.
- Auditorium chairs will be sanitized before each service with a sterile CDC-recommend solution.
- We will have volunteers guiding you inside and to the next socially distant seat(s) with your household. We ask everyone to cooperate in sitting where guided in order to keep distances safe for everyone.
 - There will be a copy of the message outline in the seatback in front of you. We will not be handing out our usual worship guides (with information for first time guests) but if you'd like one, just ask a volunteer.
 - We will not pass offering buckets; if you wish to give a financial gift we have a Giving Station with a drop slot in the Lobby or we highly encourage digital giving (information is on our website Giving page).
- You will find a bottle of hand sanitizer on your row for use as needed while you are here.
- Once you are seated you may remove your mask for the service; we suggest putting it back on for dismissal.
- You will be dismissed row-by-row, from back to front when service has concluded. This is to avoid families crossing paths and to keep distance as households exit to their cars.
 - We ask that you go directly to your car and not linger in the lobby or parking lot.

RESTROOMS (& MOTHER'S ROOM)

- Those who need to use the restroom will be allowed but limited to only one person in the restroom at a time.
- The Mother's Room can be used to change diapers but will be limited to one person in the room at a time.
- We will sanitize frequently touched surfaces often and before each service.

KIDSQUEST

- Our phase 1 re-opening will be a family-friendly worship experience, there will be no childcare.
- We will provide a packet of materials to each child that would like one.
- KIDSquest curriculum will still be provided online. We encourage parents to bring a device and headphones for children to use the KIDSquest curriculum while in the service.
