

# Central Kids In-Person Guidelines

## Safety Overview

- Reduced capacity of 20 children at **9:00 am service only** (10 children per room)
- 4 year olds through 3rd Grade
- Masks will be required for children, volunteers and all adults.
- Children will be physically distanced in the Fellowship Hall and Assembly Hall downstairs at Durham Nativity School.
- Cleaning and sanitizing will take place before, during, in between and after services.
- No snack will be served.
- Crafts will be prepackaged.
- We will maintain one way hallways with one entrance and exit.
- Extra masks will be provided if a child's does not fit or if a child does not have one.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at each entrance.
- Children will be asked to use hand sanitizer as they enter and exit



## Check-in Procedures

- Families will enter the building through the Mangum St. entrance along with other attendees.
- Children and adults will be temperature checked as they enter.
- Child Check-in traffic will be directed to the right and downstairs (follow the signs).
- **Only one parent** will allowed to bring children downstairs.
- Follow the signs down the stairwell to the Fellowship Hall.
- Parent and children will proceed across the stage (socially distanced) to check-in table.
- Children will receive a **name tag** and parent will **receive a security tag** for pick-up.
- Children will be directed to a socially distanced spot in the Fellowship Hall or the Assembly Room.
- Parent will be directed upstairs to sanctuary for worship.



## Check-out Procedures

- Same parent that dropped off should pick-up.
- Follow the exit traffic out the back of the sanctuary.
- Take the right stairwell just outside of the sanctuary downstairs for pickup.
- Follow the arrows and signs to check-out and present your security tag.

- Central Kids team member will walkie the classroom and ask for your child to come out for pick-up.
- When you have your child, continue across the stage to and back up the stairwell to exit the building.
