STORY POINT: Jesus is the best teacher.

KEY PASSAGE: Colossians 1:13 “He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved son.”

ACTIVITY: Unwrap Lazarus. Unroll a bath tissue tube. Draw a stick figure to represent Lazarus. Loosely re-roll the paper. Tell your kids to pull on the paper to unroll it once again. Show Lazarus. Tell your kids that Jesus’ friend Lazarus was very sick, and he died. People wrapped him up and put him in a tomb, but Jesus made Lazarus alive again! Those who trust in Jesus will live forever with Him. **JESUS IS OUR KING.**

THREE WAYS TO POINT YOUR LITTLE ONE TO JESUS WITH THIS STORY


- Jesus’ friend Lazarus was very sick.

BIBLE STORY:

Mary and Martha sent Jesus a message: their brother Lazarus was sick. When Jesus got to Lazarus’ house, Lazarus had been dead for four days. Martha said to Jesus, “Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died. But God will give You whatever You ask.” Jesus said, “Whoever believes in Me will never die.” Martha said, “Yes, Lord. You are the Messiah, God’s Son.” Mary came to see Jesus. She said, “Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died.” Mary was crying. They took Jesus to Lazarus’ tomb, and Jesus cried. Jesus said, “Remove the stone.” Then Jesus prayed to God, and then Jesus said, “Lazarus, come out!” Lazarus came out! Jesus made Lazarus alive again

BIG PICTURE QUESTION/CATECHISM QUESTION:

Big Picture Question:

CRAFT:

Supplies:

1. White paper plate.
2. Scissors.
3. Black marker.
4. Jumbo or regular craft stick.
5. Glue or stapler.


DESCRIPTION/MAKE: Lazarus Mask.

Using scissors, cut an oval shape in the white paper plate where your eyes would go. Then draw black lines to look like bandages. Next, glue or staple the craft stick to the plate. Now hold it up to your face and you have a Lazarus mask. **JESUS IS OUR KING**, and He is King over all creation. Jesus showed that He has power over death. Jesus made Lazarus alive again.
