- Lagenia is working on using Zoom to stay in contact with those participating in **CR**.
- **DCC Small Groups** - your leaders will stay in contact through your message and are looking at setting up Zoom for you guys to virtually meet.
- **Give** - giving is still an act of worship. Please do so through www.destinationcommunitychurch.com or through our DCCKY App.
- **Pray** - We are facing new times and want to navigate them in the most God honoring way possible. Pray for guidance and direction and the boldness to follow.
