How did we get to this point?

NOTE: The Building Campaign Team is NOT a building committee - our goal is to coordinate resources and activities to raise the funds needed to break ground.

In October 2021, Linda Fuhrman, Jamie Olcott, and Rob Wilson met with Steve Johnson, Chief Business Development Officer of Christian Investors Financial Campaign & Consulting, who has over 30 years of campaign experience and brought an understanding of the funding process to the meeting.

Since November 2021, the Building Campaign Team has been meeting monthly to pray for guidance, seek the Lord's will in this process, discuss next steps, and establish roles to be filled.

In December 2021, the Building Campaign Theme was determined. You may be asking yourself, "What is a campaign theme? What is its purpose?" WELL, a campaign theme is meant to succinctly describe the vision and provide quick understanding of our purpose. After considering our options and praying over them, we chose "Gathering, Giving, Glorifying God."

In January 2022, APC held it's annual business meeting where the Building Campaign Team shared the vision with the church as a whole to kick off the campaign, spent time in prayer as a congregation, and encouraged a commitment to continue to pray.



Where do we go from here?

First and foremost, PRAY. We invite you to join us in a commitment to pray. We believe God has given us a specific vision to bless our community with a building where people can gather and God can be glorified. Prayer aligns our hearts with His will. It is through prayer we receive assurance of the Lord’s power and direction for us to be used in His plans.

We will communicate different prayer themes and prayer events leading up to Summer 2022, our hope is that this campaign will be an opportunity for our church to experience the power of God through prayer in a fresh and exciting way. This summer we will invite our church family to commit to a multi-year financial giving plan. More details on this will be communicated in the months ahead.
