



# **Life Group Lesson**

## Lesson #4

The Word of God, the Bible, is how God has spoken to His children in every generation. It never becomes outdated, always relevant, to ground us in our ability to live in the fullness of God. Today we look at a passage from Revelation that helps us to understand the glorious risen Jesus and give us hope and vision for where HIStory ends.

On Sunday, Pastor John introduced a way to incorporate the Word into our daily encounter with God called "Praise to Prayer." The key to this process is to allow Holy Spirit to show us what to praise God for in a passage of the Bible, and then to use the truths we praised God for to pray for a particular area of need that you/your family, a friend or people in the world have.

# "Praise to Prayer" Through the Word - Revelation 7:9-17 (NIV)

**9** After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands. **10** And they cried out in a loud voice:

"Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb."

**11** All the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, **12** saying:

"Amen!
Praise and glory
and wisdom and thanks and honor
and power and strength
be to our God for ever and ever.
Amen!"

**13** Then one of the elders asked me, "These in white robes—who are they, and where did they come from?"

14 I answered, "Sir, you know."





And he said, "These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. **15** Therefore,

"they are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will shelter them with his presence.

### **Praise to Prayer Process:**

- Before reading the passage, each person asks the Lord to reveal a situation in their lives where they need breakthrough. Record this on paper or on their phones.
- Read the passage and instead of sharing with one another, use your prayers to praise God outloud for His qualities revealed in the passage. You can break this into 2 sections if you'd like (verses 9-12 and verses 13-17)
- Now use the qualities of God that were just prayed out to pray into your situation. You may consider breaking the group into smaller groups to do this portion.

# **Looking Forward**

Close your time by reflecting and sharing on how the "Praise to Prayer" experience was for people. Was there a word that Holy Spirit spoke through the Word in the process? Encourage people to repeat this exercise another time during the coming week, to allow God to deepen His Word into their lives. Break into smaller groups to share more deeply and to pray for one another to continue encountering God by allowing Holy Spirit to bring His Word to inform the things on our hearts and lead us into joy and freedom.





# **Kids Lesson**

This week we will read from Revelation 7 and reflect and focus on what it looks like to praise God! Grab a writing utensil and some paper or a notebook to write/draw with!

# Revelation 7:9-17 (NIV)

**9** After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands. **10** And they cried out in a loud voice:

"Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb."

**11** All the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, **12** saying:

## **Activity**

- 1. Read over the passage what do you notice about the praises and worship that the angels and saints and the author say that stick out to you? Write/draw any of those on your paper.
- 2. What does this passage say about God to you? Are there any characteristics of who He is? Things you notice differently about God? Write/draw it on your paper.
- 3. Now, as you look over the passage, look at the characteristics about God you wrote from step 2. Think about those words that are said. How can you praise God in your own words?
- 4. Imagine yourself in the passage, as part of the group worshipping and praising God. Are there any words you want to add to the praise? Write/draw them on your paper.
- 5. Say out loud your praise prayer to God! He loves to hear you worship Him! As we praise God, we get to learn more about Him and who He is to us and we can pray and ask God for help in all the other parts of our lives.
