CPC is entering a new digital age with a fresh new look for our website and the introduction of a mobile app. With the enthusiastic and knowledgeable support of Rev. Paul Lang, the communications team, under the capable leadership of Melinda Crouse, built our new digital assets with member and visitor engagement in mind.

The church calendar is easy to navigate, with descriptions easy to find. The website includes invitations throughout to ask for more information about programs and opportunities. A library of sermons is available on both the website and the app. The app also provides quick access to ways to communicate with church staff and with each other, including a link to the CPC member directory log in page and a one-click option to submit prayer requests.

How to Use the App

When the app opens you will be presented with the following screen:





If you'd like to:

Locate Previous Bulletins

- Tap on the Media tab at the top on the screen.
- On the next page, tap on the Archived Bulletins icon.
- This page contains links to previous worship bulletins

Listen to Previous Sermons

- Tap on the Media tab at the top on the screen.
- On the next page, tap on the Sermons icon.
- This page contains links to audio recordings of previous sermons.

Submit a Prayer Request

- Tap the Care icon on the Home page.
- On the next page, tap the Prayer Requests icon.
- Select your email provider if prompted to do so.
- An email form will appear.
- Complete the email form and tap Send.

Make a Donation

- Tap the Give icon on the Home page.
- Login or create a profile.
- Complete and submit the form.

Access the Church Directory

- Tap the Connect icon on the Home page
- On the next page, tap the CPC Member Directory icon
- This takes you to the directory log in page
- Enter your log in or password information

Watch the Current Service

- Tap the Worship Icon
- This page takes you to our website with information about worship times and a link to the CPC Facebook Page where you can watch the current worship service.

Play Previous Services

• We are beginning to store previous services in the cloud as well as on our Facebook page, so you will be able to access full worship services via the app.

Read the Bible

- At the bottom of the app home page, you'll see an icon labeled Bible
- The complete New Revised Standard Version of the Bible is available for reference and study right on our app.

- Will the new website have the same address as the existing one?

- Where do I get the Cary Presbyterian Church app?

The app is available for Android and Apple phones from their respective app stores.

To the appropriate store, search for Cary Presbyterian.

Click on the app, the icon will look like the following image and Install/Get the app.

Why should I use the app?

The app will be a quick reference to important information in the life of the church such as events, worship services and connecting with staff and groups. You'll also be able to use the app to stream worship services right on your mobile device.

Are the app and the website connected at all?

Yes, some choices on the app will bring you to website locations, such as for specific programs, like Stephen Ministry, and for online giving.

Will I miss something if I don't download the app?

The app, like the website, is a tool. Especially in these days of isolation, we have learned the importance of connectedness. While nothing can replace our person-to-person interactions, we want to be sure we are providing a variety of ways for members, friends and visitors to engage in the life of our congregation. Special announcements and the weekly elink newsletter will still arrive in your inbox or mailbox as usual.

What do I need to know to download the app?
