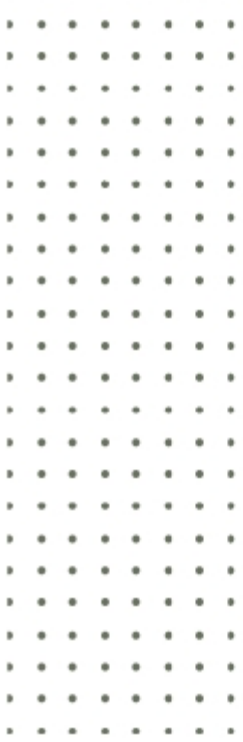


90 days OF PRAYER

THREE Pray for our mission partner: Young Life. DAY 63 // DECEMBER 11

ONE Pray that your trust in God grows, and gives you joy and a reason to sing.
