<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>God thinks I'm not good enough.</b></li> <li>2. Because God made me, I'm good!</li> <li>3. God says I'm well made.</li> </ol>	<b>Psalm 139:14 NIRV</b> <i>How you made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise you for that. ...</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. God knows all about me.</li> <li>2. God knows all about everyone.</li> <li>3. <b>God doesn't know that much about me.</b></li> </ol>	<b>Psalm 139:1 NIRV</b> <i>Lord, you have seen what is in my heart. You know all about me.</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. God likes me.</li> <li>2. <b>God is disappointed in me.</b></li> <li>3. God is delighted in me.</li> </ol>	<b>Zephaniah 3:17 NIRV</b> <i>The Lord your God is with you. ... He will take great delight in you. ...</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. God always keeps His promises.</li> <li>2. <b>God sometimes has to break a promise.</b></li> <li>3. God can always be trusted.</li> </ol>	<b>Numbers 23:19 NIRV</b> <i>God isn't a mere man. He can't lie. He isn't a human being. He doesn't change his mind. ... He makes a promise, and then he keeps it.</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>God gets angry really fast.</b></li> <li>2. God is full of love.</li> <li>3. God is slow to anger.</li> </ol>	<b>Psalm 103:8 NIRV</b> <i>The Lord is tender and kind. He is gracious. He is slow to get angry. He is full of love.</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. God saves people.</li> <li>2. God listens to people.</li> <li>3. <b>God doesn't listen to me.</b></li> </ol>	<b>Psalm 34:17 NIRV</b> <i>Godly people cry out, and the Lord hears them. He saves them from all of their troubles.</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. God loves people.</li> <li>2. <b>If I sin a lot, God will stop loving me.</b></li> <li>3. God will always love me.</li> </ol>	<b>Romans 8:39 NIRV</b> <i>... Nothing at all can ever separate us from God's love because of what Christ Jesus our Lord has done.</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>God doesn't keep me safe.</b></li> <li>2. God guards my heart.</li> <li>3. God guards my mind.</li> </ol>	<b>2 Thessalonians 3:3 NIRV</b> <i>But the Lord is faithful. He will strengthen you. He will guard you from the evil one.</i>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. God helps me get what I need.</li> <li>2. <b>God doesn't meet all my needs.</b></li> <li>3. God cares for your needs.</li> </ol>	<b>Philippians 4:19 NIRV</b> <i>My God will meet all your needs. He will meet them in keeping with his wonderful riches that come to you because you belong to Christ Jesus.</i>
