

How old does my baby need to be?

We are equipped to care for your sweet bundle as early as 6 weeks old.

What time do I need to arrive?

Classes are open 20 minutes prior to first service, and 15 minutes prior to our second and third services.

For 8:30: classes open at 8:10. For 10:00: classes open at 9:45. For 11:30: classes open at 11:15.

What if we are late?

If you arrive past the close of check in, we will do our best to get your child connected in their assigned small group but they might need to attend a different class due to capacity.

For security purposes we do not allow parents to utilize self check-in stations once Large Group has begun. Large Group begins at 8:50, 10:15, and 11:50. For the consideration of the classroom dynamic, we ask that parents do their best to arrive within the check-in times listed above.

What are the stickers all about?

Each time you check in, your child's name tag will print, as well as a parent sticker. The parent sticker contains 3 characters that correspond with your child(ren)'s tag. Be sure to keep your parent tag and present it the Small Group Leader at pick up. We check tags every Sunday at dismissal, even if we know your family!

If it is your family's first visit, your child will receive a VIP sticker. Be sure to take the VIP sticker to the red tent just outside the main entrance when you leave, and redeem the sticker for a gift!

What do I need to bring?

If your child is still in diapers, bottle feeding or has allergies to goldfish or Cheerios, please bring a bag with these items labeled with your child's name. Please keep all toys safe by leaving them at home. For our infant classrooms, we have a bag check-in station outside rooms 100 and 101. Once you have dropped off your child, complete the check-in sheet, place the items your child might need in the provided basket, and leave your labeled bag and basket in a cubby.

Who will be caring for my child?

Your child will be placed in an age appropriate small group with carefully trained and background checked Small Group Leaders. By attending the same hour each week, your child will make friends and have the same Small Group Leaders and group of children in their room.

How many kids are in each classroom?

We have child-to-volunteer ratios and maximum capacities that we keep for the safety of each age group. When necessary, we will close a room if it reaches maximum capacity or goes outside our assigned ratio. Ratios vary from 2:1 for our youngest infants to 5:1 for our oldest preschoolers. Capacities range from 10 in our infant room to 20 in our Pre-K rooms.

What do you teach?

Everything we teach in Waumba Land is centered on 3 key truths: God made me, God loves me, and Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

What is Large Group?

Waumba Land Large Group time happens in the Clubhouse each service hour. It's a time for kids to sing, dance, and listen to our Bible story of the day.

What happens in the classrooms?

We provide fun, engaging, age appropriate activities for each age group. These activities help us relate the Bible story to your child in a fun and practical way.

Is Waumba Land clean?

Yes! We know that germs are everywhere, and we do our best to keep our littlest friends from sharing them. We sanitize the toys in between each service hour and everything in the environment is professionally cleaned each week.

Do you have a nursing mother's room?

Unfortunately, we do not at this time. You are, however, welcome to come back to room 100 in Waumba Land and nurse your baby there. Just let the Kids Check-In team in the foyer know, and they will escort you back.
