Disciplinary System

- The Kids Ministry guidelines are regularly presented to the children.
- 2. If a child violates one of our guidelines, we will let the child know how they are breaking the guideline with a "warning". We will document that conversation, but will not involve the parent.
- 3. If a child violates the same guideline again, displaying a patterned behavior, the child will receive a "strike". The parent is made aware of the violation and a discussion is had about ways we could work on this behavioral problem.
- 4. If a child violates the guideline again, a second "strike" is given, and the parent is asked to stay with child during Kids programming.
- 5. If a child violates a guideline again, a third "strike" is given, and the child is removed from programming for an allotted period of time determined by April Huskev.
