Preschool Safety Protocols and Procedures

Birth - Preschool

Registration and Check-In

1. Pre-registration is required for participation each Sunday.
2. All children will be temperature checked each Sunday at check in.
3. Check-In will be managed by one volunteer to reduce contact.
4. Only volunteers and children will be allowed past the locked double doors to reduce contact.
5. Sanitizing stations will be placed at the check-in station and inside each classroom.
6. Parents will pick up their children by presenting their tags that match their child's tags at the check-in station outside of the double doors. A volunteer will bring their children to check-out.

Volunteer Requirements

7. Volunteers will go through mandatory health screenings each week before they are allowed to serve.
8. Volunteers are required to wear a mask at all times.
9. Volunteers will wash their hands before and after all diaper changes.

Children and Classroom Safety

10. Masks for preschool age children are not required.
11. Children must bring their own, labeled, water cup.
12. One pre-packaged snack per child will be provided each Sunday.
13. Each child will be assigned their own craft box each Sunday.
14. Social distancing will be practiced and reinforced.
15. Extra cleaning and disinfecting will happen before, during, and after children are in the Kids area.
16. Children will wash their hands before and after snack, and before and after restroom use.

Elementary Safety Protocols and Procedures

Kindergarten - 3rd Grade

Registration and Check-In

1. Pre-registration is required for participation each Sunday.
2. All children will be temperature checked each Sunday at check-in.
3. Check-In will be managed by one volunteer each Sunday to reduce contact.
4. Only volunteers and children will be allowed past the locked double doors to reduce contact.
5. Sanitizing stations will be placed at the check-in station and inside each classroom.
6. Parents will pick up their children by presenting their tags that match their child's tags at the check-in station outside of the double doors. A volunteer will bring their children to check-out.

Volunteer Requirements

7. Volunteers will go through mandatory health screenings each week before they are allowed to serve.

9. Masks should be worn by children unless they are in their specifically, assigned seat.
10. One small water bottle will be provided for every child each Sunday.
11. Snacks will not be provided.
12. Each child will be provided their own craft box each Sunday.
13. Social distancing will be practiced and reinforced.
14. We will avoid any activities that require close contact with each other, or masks being removed.
15. Extra cleaning and disinfecting will happen before, during, and after children are in the Kids area.
16. Children will wash their hands before and after restroom use, and any other time seen as necessary.

Preteen Safety Protocols and Procedures

4th - 6th Grade

Registration and Check-In

1. Pre-registration required for participation each Sunday and/or Wednesday. No contact check-in will be completed by volunteers.
2. All children will be temperature checked each Sunday and/or Wednesday when they arrive.
3. Sanitizing stations will be placed at the bottom of the stairs to the Preteen space and in the Preteen space.

Volunteer Requirements

4. Volunteers will go through mandatory health screenings each week before they are allowed to serve.
5. Volunteers are required to wear a mask at all times.

Children and Classroom Safety

6. Masks should be worn by children unless they are in their specifically, assigned seat.
7. One water bottle will be provided for every child each Sunday.
8. Snacks will not be provided.
9. Each child will be provided their own activity box each Sunday, if needed.
10. Social distancing will be practiced and reinforced.
11. We will avoid any activities that require close contact with each other, or masks being removed.
12. Extra cleaning and disinfecting will happen before, during, and after children are there.
13. Children will wash their hands before and after restroom use, and any other time seen as necessary.
