**Our church leadership has decided to reopen our services with a long list of precautions.** Our primary rationale was to give each person the freedom to choose which worship setting they would prefer. We are not encouraging you to come back or discouraging you from doing so, we have simply decided to open our doors and welcome those of you who would choose to worship in person at this time. We recognize the risks associated with gathering together for worship and have decided to allow the members of our congregation to choose whether they want to take those risks or not. For the time being, the 9:00 & 10:30 AM services will have the same format, songs, message, etc.

**We will continue to offer an online streaming service option,** and fully support those of you who would choose to continue to worship that way, whether it be out of health concerns or principle.

**We need you to sign up in order to make this a successful transition.** Because of our social distancing measures, we will have limited seating available and therefore are requesting that you sign up for the service you plan on attending. To further encourage social distancing practices, we have added a video feed option in the fellowship hall.

- Every other pew will be open in the sanctuary and we ask people to physically distance between different households.
- For the time being, the 9:00 & 10:30 AM services will have the same format, songs, message, etc.
- Greeters will stand off to the side and welcome people from a distance.
- The bulletin will be available for you to pick up if desired.
- There will be no meet-and-greet time during the service.
- The offering plates will not be passed, but will be at the back of the sanctuary for people to place their offering in, monitored by Offering and Attendance Team.
- We will be using individually wrapped, pre-packaged elements for Communion once a month.
- We encourage the congregation to exit outside without congregating in the back of the Sanctuary after the service.
- All items in the pew backs have been removed.
- Our janitorial staff will be actively cleaning the facility during the services.
- There will be no coffee/refreshment time.
- All Sunday School classes are postponed indefinitely.
