Books to Give Out & Read Together with a Non-Believer

What is the Gospel? By Greg Gilbert (130 pgs)

Beginning with Paul's systematic presentation of the gospel in Romans and moving through the sermons in Acts, Gilbert argues that the central structure of the gospel consists of four main subjects: God, man, Christ, and a response. The book carefully examines each and then explores the effects the gospel can have in individuals, churches, and the world. Both Christian and non-Christian readers will gain a clearer understanding of the gospel in this valuable resource.

Christianity Explored Handbook (82 pgs) + Christianity Explored Leader's Handbook

The handbook is designed to be completed while reading the gospel of Mark one week at a time for a total of 10 weeks. There is also a video series that is meant to be watched after completing each chapter of the handbook. This handbook/video series can be done one to one or in a group setting.

Practical Application Books About Evangelism

Evangelism by John MacArthur (341 pgs)

The book begins by comparing the current state of outreach in American Christianity with evangelism throughout church history and also in the Bible. MacArthur addresses the theological principles that govern evangelism, showing how they are played out in the church, as well as the family and personal interaction. It includes preaching, one-on-one witnessing, missions, parenting evangelism, and commissioning and supporting missionaries.

Tell the Truth by Will Metzger (305 pgs)

Metzger seeks to present the whole gospel which is God-centered instead of man-centered. He also highlights the pitfalls of some modern evangelism tactics while emphasizing God's grace for salvation. This book is being read by the Outreach team.

Conceptual Books About Evangelism

Evangelism & Sovereignty of God by J.I. Packer (122 pgs)

In a careful review of the biblical evidence, J.I. Packer shows how a right understanding of God's sovereignty is not so much a barrier to evangelism as an incentive and powerful support for it.

Evangelism 9marks by J. Mack Stiles (130 pgs)

J. Mack Stiles challenges us to view evangelism as something we do together instead of something we do alone, helping churches cultivate a culture of evangelism that goes beyond simply creating new programs or adopting the latest method.
