

#### WEEK 2 - BE STILL AND KNOW

**ROMANS 10:8-11, 17** 

8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim); 9 because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. 11 For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame."-

17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.

#### THE MAIN POINT:

Chronicle your own personal experience of learning to love God's Word for it is by His Word that we find our instructions/power for joyful and sanctified living in Christ.

	NOTES:
HOW TO GROW IN LOVE WITH GOD'S WORD	
POINT #1: PSALM 119:36 PRAY that you would love God's Word Tip: Routinely pray for this love whether it is every night or every day.	
POINT #2: PSALM 119:27 READ-PRAY with regularity & assistance Tip: Get a study bible money well-spent! The Life Application Bible is a good one (and it's available digitally!)	
POINT #3: HEB. 4:12 & 2 TIM 3:16  APPLY God's Word to life  Tip: look for ways to see how God's ways are better in your life.  POINT #4: MATTHEW 25:29	
YEARN-YIELD for more of God's Word Tip: Stay humble in your learning of God's Word. Watch out for complacency and excuses.

#### SMALL GROUP TIME

#### 1. CONNECT VULNERABLY

How was your week? Were there times where you intentionally sought out to read the Bible?

#### 2. DISCUSS RESPECTFULLY

- (a) What is the main point today? Have you ever thought about the idea that one day you will look back and see what your experience with God's Word has been like?
- (b) Briefly describe your own personal experience with the Bible.
- (c) How was the time of going through God's Word in Romans 10:5-17?

#### 3. ENCOURAGE ONE ANOTHER

- (a) Would you be willing to commit to buying a study Bible (physically or digitally or both)?
- (b) Create an account on YouVersion and befriend each other.
- (c) Look up a Bible plan (perhaps in YouVersion) you can do together this week (recommend no more than a five day one).

#### 4. FOSTER COMMUNITY

- (a) Continue to take time to "be still and know" with a worship song from your playlist.
- (b) Take time to complete the YouVersion Bible plan each day and leave a comment in the group Bible Plan.
- (c) Text/chat with each other throughout the week as the Spirit leads.





# I Be Still and know

Find time to STOP and sit with the Lord. Morning? Night? Waiting to be picked up? On the school bus?

Listen to a favorite worship song or read a psalm/proverb. Connect to the Lord during this time. Tell Him how you are feeling.

Recommended time = 5 to 10 min

# **Read the Bible**

Read a portion of scripture or a daily devotion in your Bible plan.

BEFORE YOU DO... ask the Holy Spirit to give you spiritual understanding.

Recommended time = 10-20 min

### Listen and write

Take time to ask God questions. What does He want to teach you? What are His thought about you? Does He have an assignment for you?

Write these things down. Think of this as a combination of journaling and having a conversation. Refer back to these things as life happens to see God's work in your life.

Recommended time = 5 to 15 min

# \*A Youth Pastor's note\*

There is nothing wrong with a good devotional/Bible plan. But I have come to find that I sometimes don't connect with Jesus and just read to "check a box".

After years of walking with the Lord I was taught this method of daily meeting with Jesus and I haven't found anything better for me. Sometimes I only do one or two steps. Other times I do all four steps. You will figure out what works best for you.

The goal is to meet with our loving Heavenly Father.

He is sincerely interested in building a history with His sons and daughters that is done in the secret place.

# Pray (Intercede)

This is the time to pray for yourself. Pray for friends to come to know Jesus. Pray for any prayer requests people have shared with you. Pray for your church. Pray for your friends at youth group. Pray for your advisors/youth pastor.

Recommended time = 5 to 1000 min
