Build with Blocks

Invite your child to build with blocks. Read the Bible story (reverse side) as your child plays. Talk about how the people were not kind to Isaac, but he was kind. Say that he turned and walked away.

Ask your child how he can be kind when playing with blocks.

Model the kind behavior.

BABIES

Play in the Tub

Put this page inside a ziplock bag. Float the bag in the bath water. Talk about the Bible story of Isaac being kind. Mention that a well holds water. Say that even though the men tried to take Isaac's wells. he still showed kindness to the men.

Make Mud

Go outside. Fill a bowl with water. Read the Bible story to your child. Ask her what the unkind people did. Add dirt to the water as you say the people added dirt to the well. Show the child how to smash the dirt around with her hands (or stir with a large spoon). Ask her if she would like to drink the water in the bowl now. Say: "No, because it is dirty." (Do not drink the water.) Talk about how Isaac dug another well. Thank God for kind people.

LIVE IT OUT

Briefly review the Bible story with your child. Talk about ways your family could end a conflict to get along with your neighbors. Remind your child that God wants people to get along with others.
