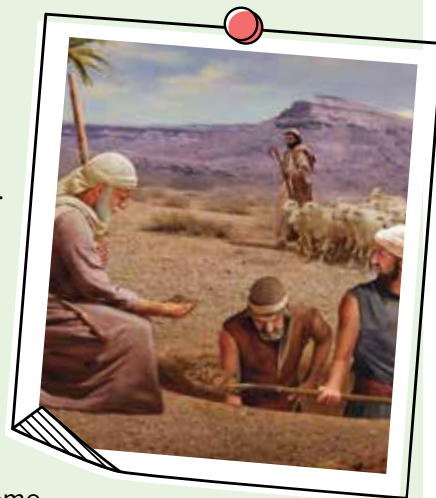
CONVERSATION

Isaac Was Kind

BASED ON GENESIS 26:12-33

WEEKLY VERSE: Do good to everyone.
Galatians 6:10

LIFE POINT: People can choose to get along with others.



Isaac had lots of food. He also had many cows and sheep. He had so many animals and so much food that some people did not like him.

One day some people put dirt in Isaac's wells. Isaac could not get water for his animals or his family. So Isaac had to move.
