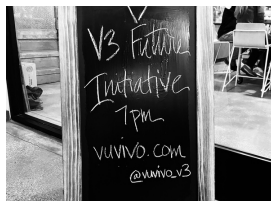

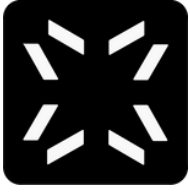
As the "malaise" of our disenchanted age continues to become more acute and widespread, so does the longing for enchanted reality. And this longing, while more acute, is not new. In fact, J.R.R. Tolkien, C.S. Lewis, Owen Barfield, and other members of the informal literary group, The Inklings, felt it. In response, they hoped "to restore Western culture to its religious roots, to unleash the powers of the imagination, to reenchanted the world...."

While carrying nowhere near the weight of a roster like that, our team is aiming in the same direction. We want people to "know the reality of Jesus Christ." The reality that Paul wrote of in his letter to the Colossians saying, "For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together." Reality is in fact, enchanted and it is just waiting to be uncovered!

Each week we are uncovering a little more enchanted reality through Chapel, our Future Initiative, LAB: The Podcasts, Communities of Practice, and we pray soon through our expanded ministry at the V3 Conservatory in Tampa. Together with you, we are responding to the deep longing for meaning and connection in an increasingly disenchanted culture and church. Nothing but the life and beauty of the gospel can do that and we are so grateful for your prayers and partnership.

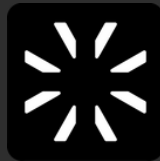

I can hardly believe it's mid-February of 2022!

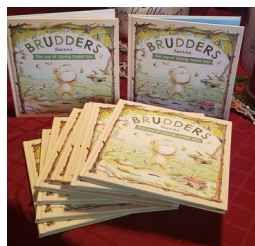
As V3's Ministry Director, I get to hear and witness the behind-the-scenes stories of God's goodness and his incredible faithfulness throughout our team and beyond.
