

PROJECT 2021 COVID STATEMENT

In light of the pandemic, we want you (and your parents) to know that your health and safety are a priority for us on Project. While our vision remains the same, we will implement several precautions in order to help minimize the risks involved with COVID-19. Please note that the following is subject to change depending on the implementation of vaccines and cases at the time of Project.

Prior to Project:

- » Each student and staff will be asked to send a *negative COVID test result* taken within ten days of Project.
 - › Please send results taken between 5/1 and 5/10 to your Campus Outreach Director from your campus.
 - › Note: This does not apply to students or staff who have been fully vaccinated. Please send a picture of your vaccine card.
- » Students are encouraged to semi-quarantine and practice social distancing in the week leading up to Project. If you become symptomatic, please contact the Campus Outreach staff from your campus to make them aware.
- » Each student will complete a health screen form within 24 hours of arrival.

At Project:

- » Staff will take each student's temperature and complete a health screening upon arrival.
- » Everyone will wear a mask and practice social distancing at all indoor events. We will maximize the use of outdoors as much as possible.
- » Hand sanitizer will be used before and after every event.
- » Facilities and rooms will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized prior to arrival and throughout Project.
- » In the unfortunate event that a student becomes symptomatic, we will have rooms on site set aside for him or her to self-isolate until he or she is able to leave. We will also ask that his or her roommates would quarantine until testing results are in.

After Project:

- » Students are encouraged to semi-quarantine, wear a mask, and practice social distancing in the week following Project.
- » If you begin to experience symptoms following Project, please contact the Project Director for contact tracing purposes.
