Frequently Asked Questions:

Are masks required?

Masks will be required for all those volunteering and participating in the Christmas Shoppe.

Will we be able to social distance and keep space in the Shoppe?

Yes. We have extended the hours of the Shoppe and limited the amount of families that will be shopping every hour. This will help ensure that we can keep space between all individuals.

How early should I arrive for my shift?

Shift hours are scheduled to allow for preparation and instruction within all areas of the Shoppe, early arrival is not necessary. Personal Shoppers should plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your assigned family's arrival time, and 30 minutes early if it's your first time serving in this role.

Can I volunteer for multiple shifts?

Absolutely! Mark as many shifts as your schedule allows on a single volunteer form.

Will food be provided for volunteers that work multiple shifts?

Unfortunately no. Feel free to bring a snack with you if need be!

Is childcare available for my children during my volunteer shift?

Due to limited space and other factors, childcare is not provided for Christmas Shoppe volunteers.
