Greetings family. Questions are flying about, regulations are changing weekly, guidance is often confusing.

So where do we stand as a church community and what are we doing?

Your questions here:

1) When will we resume indoor meetings?

> we are targeting June 20 to start indoor Sunday services - more details below

2) Why wait so long?

> there are a number of improvement projects in progress in the church building that prevent us from meeting inside at this time - painting, flooring, cleaning, A/V wiring and set-up, bathroom updates and maintenance, and more. We are moving along on these projects as quickly as we can

> we are working on a plan to minister to and care for our children. The challenges are many, not the least of which is the need for a large number of people to serve our children. The Children's Ministry team is working hard, praying, and planning. More info to come.

3) Do we have to take temperatures every gathering?

> we have deleted temperature checks from our gatherings

4) What are the current WGBC mask policies until June 20?

> please mask for our outdoor services. Masks are optional when seated / listening.

5) What are our social distancing policies?

> please seek to maintain 6 feet of distance from others who are not in your "family circle" at all times

6) What is our meeting plan going forward?

- > Come Sunday, June 20 we are planning the following:
- **Sunday Service 10:00AM** with three simultaneous options:
 - 1) indoor gathering masks required
- 2) outdoor gathering with video feed of service masks optional / shade & children's activity packets provided
 - 3) online livestream of service

• Children's Church & Youth Service 10:00AM

- 1) classes for children age 2.5 years and up (online kid's service will be discontinued)
- 2) Nursery: the cry room will be open & available for children under 2.5 years accompanied by a parent.
- **Conversation / Adult Elective** will meet at 9:00 in-person on campus.
