ELEMENTARY ACTIVITIES

Guess the Cereal

In this game, the kids take turns guessing the type of cereal in each bowl.

SUPPLIES

- Cereal (3 different types, 1 c. of each)
- Bowls (3)
- Towels (3)
- Index cards (1 per child)
- Pens

SET UP

Put each type of cereal in a different bowl. Cover the bowls with towels and place them on a table in front of the group.

RELATE

When Jesus came to His disciples, He made them breakfast on the beach! Today we are going to try to guess what kind of cereal is for breakfast. Choose three students to come forward. Each child will take a turn reaching into the bowl to touch the cereal and guess what it is without looking at it or showing the rest of the group. The students can write down their guesses on an index card to keep from revealing their guesses out loud to the remaining children. Then, invite three more students to come up to feel the cereal and write a guess. Give each student a turn. Once everyone makes her guess, remove the towels from the bowls of cereal and announce the answers for the group.

After the game, discuss: **What do you think it was like for Peter to see Jesus that day? What would you say to Jesus if He made you breakfast?**
