## JOB Part 6 of 6 - God Responds

Passages from which the May 3 sermon will be drawn are below.

Read them out loud together:

## **Chapters**

38	39
40	41

As your reader proceeds, try to discern where God is (if at all) responding *directly* to Job's words and concerns.

How does it correct / change Job's understanding?

How does it transform your understanding of God?

By contrast, identify where God is simply instructing Job (& by extension us) on His character, work, & purposes. IOW, could these statements be anywhere in scripture, not just here in the context of Job's story?

What do you make of these? Does anything here transform your understanding? Motivations?

You may or may not land on any firm conclusions in your study time together. That's OK!

I want you to continue to work through this high, and sometimes difficult-to-grasp poetry. The ancients thought and wrote much differently than we. The more time we spend with them, the better we get at understanding their expressions.

Either way, ask the Lord to give you new insight and wisdom, and to feed you through his Spirit.

There is great benefit in carefully considering Scripture even when you cannot sort out all the details and concepts.
