

# On the Road

## Philip and the Ethiopian Man

### SUPPLIES

- Butcher paper (5', white or gray)
- Double-sided tape
- Person template (see Resources)
- Card stock (one sheet may be used by multiple people)
- Scissors
- Markers

### PREPARE AHEAD

Print copies of the Person template onto the card stock, one shape per child. Cut them out. Draw a road on the butcher paper, approximately five feet long, by drawing two straight lines with a dashed line down the middle.

### SET UP

Use the tape to hang the road on the wall at the children's eye level.

### RELATE

Invite kids to walk with giant steps over to the tables. **Philip shared the good news that Jesus is the way with the Ethiopian man on the road. God led Philip to the man. Let's all calm our bodies and quiet our minds. Is there someone in your life that you can share about Jesus with? Jesus wants everyone to be told how He is the only way to be with God forever. What would you like to tell that person?**

Once children have thought of someone they'd like to share Jesus with, give them a blank person cut out and encourage them to write that person's name down. If they were unable to write the full name, you can assist or have the kids just write the first letter of the name. Then invite children to bring their person to the road. Give them a piece of tape and encourage them to attach the person on the road. As each person is added to the road, share that the child can place her hand over her person cut out and say a prayer, silently or out loud, for the person she's adding to the road. Pray for the children, asking God's Holy Spirit to be with them as they tell others that Jesus is the way.

Optional: some people may want to add multiple people to the road. Consider providing more blank templates for the children to write on.
