

Community Group Question Guide – For May 5, 2019

Psalm 122 – Let Us Go!

A Song of Ascents. Of David.

- ¹ I was glad when they said to me,
“Let us go to the house of the Lord!”
- ² Our feet have been standing
within your gates, O Jerusalem!
- ³ Jerusalem—built as a city
that is bound firmly together,
⁴ to which the tribes go up,
the tribes of the Lord,
as was decreed for Israel,
to give thanks to the name of the Lord.
- ⁵ There thrones for judgment were set,
the thrones of the house of David.
- ⁶ Pray for the peace of Jerusalem!
“May they be secure who love you!
- ⁷ Peace be within your walls
and security within your towers!”
- ⁸ For my brothers and companions' sake
I will say, “Peace be within you!”
- ⁹ For the sake of the house of the Lord our God,
I will seek your good.

- Read through the psalm together then:
 - > Discuss and try to agree upon a one-word summary of verses 1-2
 - > Do the same for verses 3-5, and again for 6-9
- Read through the psalm again and replace Jerusalem with “San Jose” or “Silicon Valley”
- Pray through the psalm together as a group, taking it one section at a time as divided above:
 - > Stop after each section and pray as you are led
 - > Very carefully listen to others pray before you add your voice...
- Does this Psalm change your outlook at all regarding gathering with our church family?
 - > Praying and caring for our community?
- Does it give you any new inspiration or language?
