Activity

Ways to Create and Help Brainstorm

What You Need:

Paper, tape, and marker

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Divide the paper into two columns. On the left-hand column, write “CREATE,” and on the right-hand column, write “HELP.”

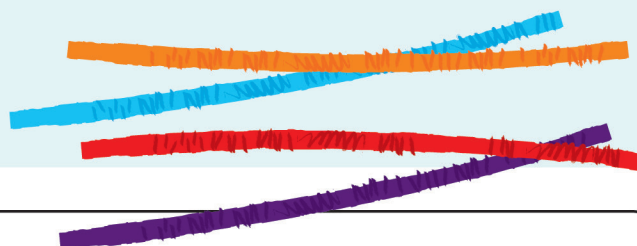
During the Activity: Point at “CREATE” and say it to your child. Name some ways God has made us to be creative and list them on the page (dance, sing, draw, build, paint, etc.). Then point to “HELP” and say it to your child. Name some ways God has made us to help and list them on the page (cleaning, saying kind words, carrying something, clearing the table, etc.).

What You Say:

Before the Activity: Say, “In our Bible story today, we learned that God created us to be like Him. God gave us our amazing brains that can think and are so, so creative. And He also gave us hands and feet to help!”

Say, “This word says, ‘CREATE.’ (Point.) What are some ways we can be creative? (Write these ideas in the “CREATE” column.) This word says, ‘HELP.’ (Point.) What are some ways we can help? (Write these ideas in the “HELP” column.)

After the Activity: Say, “God made us to be like Him. That means we can think, help and create. That’s so wonderful! Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful.”
