5 Things You Should Know About Spiritual Gifts

1. Spiritual gifts are special abilities given by God for the common good of the body of Christ (church).

Galatians 5:13 – serve one another in love

2. Every believer has at least one spiritual gift.

1 Corinthians 12:7 – Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.

3. There is no better or worse spiritual gift, no more important or less important spiritual gift.

1 Corinthians 12:11, 18 – All these are the work of one and the same Spirit and he give them (spiritual gifts) to each one, just as he determines...But in fact God has arranged the parts I the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be.

4. God expects us to discover our spiritual gift(s) and serve somewhere in order to strengthen the body of Christ.

1 Peter 4:10 – Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms.

5. There are various ways to discover and confirm one's spiritual gift:

- **Ask others** who know you well to tell you where they feel your strengths are.
- **Begin serving** and see where you are most productive and fruitful.
- **Take a spiritual gifts test** in order to identify your strongest gifts.

Take the time to carefully complete the following spiritual gifts test in order to help you discover where and how God has gifted you. Don't forget that the primary purpose of your completing this test is not merely to discover your gift, but to help you find a meaningful place of service.

Definitions of Spiritual Gifts

Administration	The ability to organize, manage, and plan in order to help a ministry run smoothly and efficiently.
Craftmanship	The ability to work with your hands to creatively design, construct, or maintain items to be used in ministry.
Creative Communication	The ability to communicate God's truth artistically (music, drama, art, video).
Discernment	The ability to instinctively perceive how others are doing and/or ability to distinguish between right and wrong.
Encouragement	The ability to come alongside an individual who may be hurting or wavering in their faith, and offer them comfort and strength to walk and trust in the Lord.
Evangelism	The ability to communicate the gospel in such a way that the unbeliever becomes a disciple and follower of Jesus Christ.
Faith	The ability to act with extraordinary confidence based upon God's promises, power, and presence.
Giving	The ability and willingness to contribute money and resources to the work of God with cheerfulness and liberality.
Helps	The ability to accomplish practical and necessary tasks that free up, support, and meet the needs of others.
Healing	The ability to heal and restore people to wholeness (physically, emotionally, or spiritually).
Hospitality	The ability to cheerfully open your home to provide lodging, food and fellowship.
Intercession	The ability, willingness, and discipline to faithfully pray for individuals and ministries.
Knowledge	The ability to bring truth to the body through biblical insight.
Leadership	The ability to direct, motivate, and influence people in such a way that they harmoniously work to accomplish the church's work.
Mercy	The ability to empathize, feel compassion, and practically help those who are hurting.
Prophecy	The ability to confidently speak God's truth in order to bring about understanding, correction, repentance, or edification.
Shepherding	The ability to nurture, care-for, and guide people toward spiritual maturity.
Teaching	The ability to understand, clearly explain, and apply God's Word, causing greater likeness in the lives of listeners.
Wisdom	The ability to see life and truth from God's perspective and then apply that wisdom to specific situations.
