

WORSHIP GENERAL INFORMATION

- Reservations are still needed, both for previous attenders and future attenders. Use the link in this email to register your attendance.
- Our online option will continue on Facebook Live and on Youtube Sundays at 10am AND 7:30pm.
- Masks and all the other guidelines in the section below are still in place.
- All are encouraged to reassess personal health and the health of people encountered during the past 2 weeks before making a reservation.
- **VOLUNTEERING:** Please indicate in your reservation whether you can assist with passing out masks before the service. Thank you for helping us build a good volunteer list.

OUTDOOR SERVICE, 7:30PM

- Bring your lawn chairs to sit.
- Remain socially distanced in your seating arrangements and avoid physical contact.
- This is a casual, outdoor service; please feel free to bring a cold drink and dress for the warm weather.
- In-car seating works well. The cooler parking spaces are the shaded ones on the lower lot.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** we will have flags stuck in the ground to help people place their chairs in a social-distance fashion. Because we know several do not want to be on camera we will be sure to take that into account as well.

Below are the guidelines for in-person worship.

We encourage you to continue to worship at home if:

- You have had a fever of 100.4° F or higher in the Friday and Saturday before worship,
- You have symptoms typical of COVID-19, or
- You have had known exposure to someone with COVID-19 in the 14 days prior two worship.

- You are 65 and above or if you have an underlying at-risk health condition(s). You are at greater risk for COVID-19.
- You are unwilling to observe the practices outlined in the next section.

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, we are implementing the following practices

- Practice social distancing by maintaining a minimum of 6 feet while gathering or seated
- Families will be allowed to sit together but must maintain social distancing from others at all times. Seating will be arranged in family grouping and space will be allotted for compliance in social distancing.
- Receptacles to leave an offering at the back of the worship space.
- No pens or bulletins will be distributed.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available at the entrances for indoor worship.
- The Welcome Center and the FLC/keypad entrance are the only two entrances that will be in use for indoor worship.
- Additional precautions and procedures will be in use for the set-up and cleaning of worship space, hallways, bathrooms, and entrances.
- All attendees will be required to wear a face covering to enter our building(s).
 - Face coverings are required AT ALL TIMES in the building for anyone over 10 years of age and are optional for children between the ages of 2 and 10 years, with the exception of worship leadership.
 - CDC guidelines prohibit face coverings for children under 2 years of age
 - If you or one of your family members does not have a face covering, the church will provide one at the door.

The following activities and amenities will remain suspended

- Physical contact such as hand shaking, touching, embracing, etc.
- Meet & Greet times
- Passing of the Offering Plates or Sign-in Pads
- Altar rail activities
- Refreshments (Coffee)
- Childcare and Sunday School for all ages.
