# Break It Down

### THINK ABOUT THIS:

Break It Down is a four-week series designed to help middle schoolers read, understand, and apply the truths of the Bible to their lives. Abstract ideas can be hard for middle schoolers to grasp and even harder for them to see played out in their own lives. That makes something like the Bible—a very big and seemingly abstract book—intimidating, uninteresting, or just plain confusing for a lot of middle schoolers. This series is designed to help relieve some of those tensions surrounding the Bible by breaking it down with a simpler, more phase-appropriate approach that middle schoolers can better understand.

## Week One

**John 1:1; John 1:14a;  
Colossians 1:15**

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# Middle School

## DAILY CUES

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### Morning Time

**T**ake time to memorize Psalm 119:105 as a family. Write it down, post it somewhere you can see it, and work to memorize it together. As you do, talk about the importance of keeping God's Word in your heart so it's there when you need it.

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### Drive Time

**T**o help them think about context, remind your kid that there is always more to the story than they know! The next time you hear your middle schooler talking about someone or something they don't understand, simply reply with this guidance: "Maybe there's more to the story that we don't know."



### Meal Time

**A**sk your kid to teach you something new—something they love! Whether it's a TikTok dance, an instrument, a video game, a makeup tutorial, or simply how to shoot a basketball, let them break it down for you to learn and do yourself.

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### Bed Time

**S**pend time in the Bible together by reading the YouVersion devotionals associated with this series. Download the YouVersion Bible app and search "Break It Down" to find the devos. Then, read and talk about one each night this week with your middle schooler.
