

Worship Update for 7-29-2021

- All are encouraged to reassess personal health and the health of people encountered during the past 2 weeks before making a reservation.

Below are **NEW** the requirements for in-person worship.

NEW MASK Requirement

- On July 27th the Church's Administrative Board voted, due to CDC mask guidance & increased hospitalizations in Arkansas, to make the **wearing of masks for everyone required**.
- All Worship participants, school aged and older, must wear a mask.
- Participants, school aged and older, at all activities must wear a mask.
- Please continue to stay home when you are not feeling well.
- Please practice good hand sanitizing.

We encourage you to continue to worship at home if:

- You have had a fever of 100.4° F or higher in the Friday and Saturday before worship,
- You have symptoms typical of COVID-19, or
- You have had known exposure to someone with COVID-19 in the 14 days prior two worship.
- You are 65 and above or if you have an underlying at-risk health condition(s). You are at greater risk for COVID-19.
- You are unwilling to observe the practices outlined in the next section.

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, we are implementing the following practices

- Practice social distancing by maintaining a minimum of 6 feet while gathering or seated in Worship services and 3 feet distance during Sunday School classes.
- Families will be allowed to sit together but must maintain social distancing from others at all times. Seating will be arranged in family grouping and space will be allotted for compliance in social distancing.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available at the entrances for indoor worship.
- Additional precautions and procedures will be in use for the set-up and cleaning of worship space, hallways, bathrooms, and entrances.

The following activities and amenities will be limited due to social distancing:

- Physical contact such as hand shaking, touching, embracing, etc.
- Meet & Greet times
- Altar rail activities
