



On June 7, we will be regathering groups for preschoolers and elementary kids. We look forward to seeing you and your family. As you join us, you will notice some changes that we have put in place so that everyone feels confident returning to in-person groups and services.

FAMILY SCREENING

Before arriving on campus, screen yourself and your child before coming to your Parkway Campus for any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19:

- Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills, Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain, Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19

If you have symptoms, please do not come until you (or your child) is 3 days fever-free. If you have close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 patient, please do not attend for 14 days.

In the event that a child exhibits symptoms of any illness while they are with us, they will be removed from their groups, and parents will be notified immediately.

LEADER AND STAFF SCREENING

Before you arrive on campus, all staff and serving teams will be screened to ensure health and readiness to serve. Those who are sick or have been exposed to someone who is ill will be sent home and won't be serving your kids.

CHECK-IN

Check-in will take place outside with a quick and easy process. We will use handwritten tags so that things keep moving and social distancing standards can be maintained.

SMALL GROUPS

When you enter the building, one parent will drop your kids in age or grade-specific small group rooms. In addition to all small group activities, all activities such as worship and teaching that are normally done in large groups will now be done in a small group setting. No snacks or drinks will be provided during group times.

PICK UP

When the service is over, one parent may come and pick up kids from their small groups. Parents are encouraged to follow the traffic pattern set up at their campus to limit congestion in hallways.

SANITIZATION STANDARDS

Before each service, small group rooms and common area touch points will be sanitized. We will also not be sharing toys or group supplies between multiple groups or multiple services. So that we can clean rooms between services, drop off for kids won't begin until 15 minutes before each service.
