**17-Nov:** Going & Serving Internationally

**Series Summary:** Scripture clearly teaches us that every believer in Jesus is called to live on a mission (Matthew 28:18-20). We are all missionaries sent out into the mission field both locally and abroad (Acts 1:8).

**Series Call to Action:** Take your next step to go on mission for Jesus

**Get Them Talking:** If you could travel anywhere in the world, where would you go?

**Leader Note:** Tonight, we focus on how God sends believers globally to tell others about Jesus. We will look at how Paul and Silas traveled together as God led them.

Read Matthew 28:19-20 and Acts 1:8.

**Matthew 28:19-20** **19** Therefore go and make disciples of *all nations*, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

**Acts 1:8** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

What do these two passages teach us about where we are to take the Gospel?

**Leader Note:** We are to go make disciples of all nations - literally all people groups. We are to go make disciples to the ends of the earth - every nation.

How does God spread His message to the ends of the earth and to all people?

**Leader Note:** God leads His church, even students like in your group, to go and tell others about Jesus so that disciples are made.
