At Gateway Night, our whole church serves, learns, and eats together. In order to do this well, this team leads the logistics, collaborates with other teams, and designs the learning sessions for adults.

Key Aspects and Core Responsibilities

Logistics

- Setting the annual calendar
- Coordinate with our location host
- Set meal themes
- Oversee the volunteer recruitment process (SignUp Genius, currently)
- Coordinate on sight during the night to make sure folks are able to serve

Adult Learning Sessions

• Curating seminars that help our adults learn and grow in their faith

Collaboration

- Session Coordinate adult discipleship topics with where we are as a church
- Kid's Coordinate volunteer recruitment for the various kid's sections



Gateway Night Team Structure

Term

Each person on the team commits to serve for 3 years. They can serve a second consecutive 3-year term, but then they take a one-year sabbatical for leading in that area. They can still serve as a volunteer, but they need to step off the leadership team for a year. For college students, their terms can be shorter depending on their anticipated graduation. Terms will follow the calendar year, beginning in January and ending in December.

Facilitator

The Gateway Night MLT leads - the team facilitator serves by helping the team lead. They are the point of contact, and they make sure the team works together and stays on mission.

Leadership Development

The Gateway Night MLT will be working to grow leaders who understand how to lead with skill, wisdom, and grace. These leaders will come from our whole congregation, so the Ministry Leadership Teams will be composed of young and old, rich and poor, and male and female (Joel 2). Teams and future facilitators will be built in collaboration with the Session every fall so that new leaders can begin in January.

Team Composition

The Gateway Night MLT is a team of 3-6 active, regular Gateway worshippers. Of this group, one Team Member should be a current student at Grove City College and one should be a current student at Slippery Rock University.
